Five round swiss type tournament played

Top three places receive U.S.C.F. membership plus "Chess Life".

Winner receives full plane fare to Boise for finals (or equiv., as above)*

If 13-20 entries

Five round swiss type tournament played

Top four places receive U.S.C.F. membership plus "Chess Life".

Winner receives full plane fare, 2nd place 1/2 fare (or equiv., as above)*

If over 20 entries

Five round swiss type tournament played

Top five places receive U.S.C.F. membership including "Chess Life".

Winner and runner-up receive full plane fare (or equiv., as above)*

*(If 30 or more entries, 3rd place receives 1/2 fare)

*# Plane fare determined by Idaho Chess Assn. Not applicable to those near Boise.

*# If attending finals: Next two places in all tournaments, below those receiving
