Winner receives full transportation allowance to Boise for finals.\*#

If 11-20 entries

Five round swiss type tournament played  
Top four places receive year's membership in USCF plus "Chess Life",  
and are eligible to play in finals.

Winner receives full transportation allowance to Boise for finals  
and 2nd place 1/2 allowance.\*#

If 21-30 entries

Five round swiss type tournament played  
Top five places receive year's membership in USCF plus "Chess Life",  
and are eligible to play in finals.

Winner and runner-up receive full transportation allowance to Boise  
for finals.\*#

If over 30 entries

Five round swiss type tournament played  
Top six places receive year's membership in USCF plus "Chess Life",  
and are eligible to play in finals.

Winner and runner-up receive full transportation allowance to Boise  
for finals and 3rd place receives 1/2 allowance.\*#
